## I. Situation Overview

On 27 March 2023 at around 12:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Quirino Ave., Brgy. Don Galo, Parañaque City. The fire was due to faulty electrical wiring. It was declared fire out at around 3:28 AM.

### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 74,168 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 30,521 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 43,647 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 6,889 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱286.9 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
