I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2023 at around 1AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Gemelina, Brgy. Estaca, Compostela, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 5:39 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱671.31 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 102,693 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 24,546 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 78,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 41,166 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱354.31 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

21 March 2023	 The LGU of Compostela, Cebu provided hot meals to the families affected by the fire incident. DSWD FO VII provided FNIs such as FFPs, family kits, kitchen kits, and sleeping kits.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

21 March 2023	 The LGU of Compostela, Cebu administered validation of affected families through the use of Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC).

d. Other Activities

21 March 2023	 DSWD FO VII continuously coordinated with the LGU of Compostela, Cebu for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO VII through its Municipal Action Team immediately responded and assisted the social workers of the Local Social Welfare and Development Office (LSWDO) of the LGU of Compostela, Cebu in the administration of DAFAC.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO VII for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.

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
