1. Standby Funds

- ₱671.83 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO V.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 107,099 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 32,772 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 74,327 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 35,757 FFPs available at DSWD FO V.
- ₱372.63 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.
