

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Merville, Parañaque City

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2023 at around 10:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Barcelona Dulo, Brgy. Merville, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 2:03 AM.

- 6,889 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱314.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
