DSWD FO V assisted the affected families in complying the requirements for the provision of financial assistance through Assistance for Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS).

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO V for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
