### I. Situation Overview

On 02 March 2023 at around 11 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pantal, Dagupan City, Pangasinan. The cause of fire was due to a short circuit in an electrical wiring.

- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 13,875 FFPs available at DSWD FO I.
- ₱389.4 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO I warehouses.
