- 121,471 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 67,324 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 31,277 FFPs available at DSWD FO V.
- ₱383.28 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.
