1. Standby Funds

- ₱748.73 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO CAR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 40,660 FFPs available at DSWD FO CAR.
- ₱398.75 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CAR warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

c. Other Activities

The LGU of Atok, Benguet provided financial assistance amounting to ₱3,000.00. DSWD FO CAR coordinated with concerned LGUs and other offices for significant disaster response updates and any request of relief augmentation.
