- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 31,277 FFPs available at DSWD FO V.
- ₱383.87 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO V warehouses.
