2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 98,050 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 27,603 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 70,447 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,443 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱352.59 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
