1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 120,075 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 70,728 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 49,347 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,571 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱369.89 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
