

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Upper Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 12 March 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 January 2023 at around 4:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 10, Purok 6, Brgy. Upper Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City. It was declared fire out at around 4:28 PM. The cause of fire is due to electrical ignition caused by a loose connection.
