## I. Situation Overview

On 18 March 2023 at 2:00 PM, a strong wind incident occurred in the Municipality of Alabel, Sarangani due to localized thunderstorms causing damages to houses.

- 104,819 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 38,672 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 66,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 29,069 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱363.81 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
