



DSWD DROMIC Report #14 on the Series of Earthquake Events in New Bataan, Davao de Oro

as of 24 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 March 2023 at 4:43 AM, a 5.3-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of New Bataan, Davao De Oro (07.45°N, 126.24°E - 015 km S 47°E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus of 004 km.

On 07 March 2023 at 2:02 PM, a 5.9-magnitude earthquake jolted again the Municipality of New Bataan, Davao De Oro (07.47°N, 126.19°E - 010 km S 33°E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus of 002 km. At 4:47 PM on the same day, a 5.6-magnitude earthquake hit the said municipality (07.51°N, 126.24°E - 012 km S 69°E) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus of 011 km.

Forty (40) patients in at Davao de Oro Provincial Hospital were provided medical assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS). Each patient received ₱4,000.00. DSWD FO XI conducts Disaster Response Cluster Agency meeting to discuss next steps and actions to be undertaken and address the needs of the affected families and individuals. DSWD FO XI attended the Briefing on the Davao de Oro Series of Earthquake Events with personnel from the DOST-PHIVOLCS, Office of Civil Defense (OCD) XI, and other member agencies of Regional Response Cluster.
08 March 2023	 DSWD FO XI distributed ₱3,000.00 financial assistance to each of the 1,870 families in the Municipalities of Compostela, Maragusan, Monkayo, Montevista, and New Bataan in Davao de Oro. DSWD FO XI deployed personnel to augment in the Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) in Davao de Oro.
06 March 2023	 DSWD FO XI in collaboration with the OCD provided an orientation to LGUs on the categorization of damaged houses.
