

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 24 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2023, an armed conflict transpired at the boundaries of Sitio Punol, Brgy. Udtong and Purok Zacaria, Brgy. Sigayan in the Municipality of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat between the 106th Brigade Division and alleged armed groups.

A total of **694 families** or **3,470 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).

There are **288 families** or **1,440 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Gym** in **Brgy. Udtong, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 2).

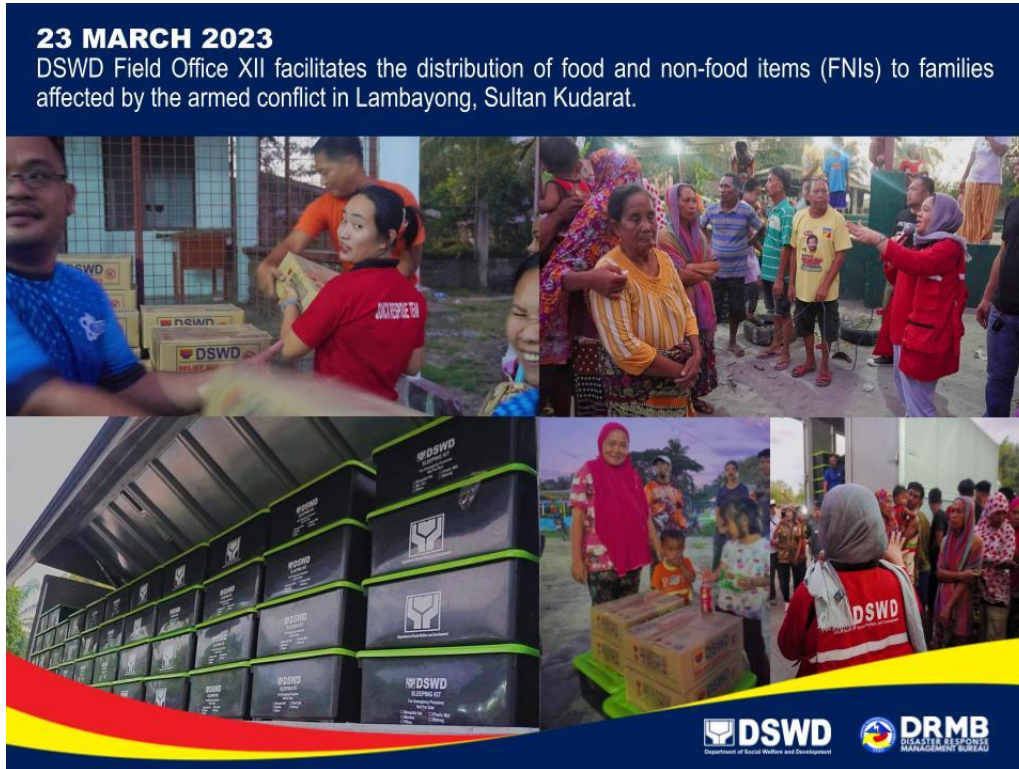
c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)
