## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 74,840 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 39,993 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 4,287 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱273.45 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
