1. Standby Funds

- ₱671.31 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3.58 million available at DSWD FO II.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 102,693 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 24,546 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 78,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 55,638 FFPs available at DSWD FO II.
- ₱337.64 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO II warehouses.
