

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Talisay City, Cebu

as of 06 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 March 2023 at around 4:28 PM, a fire incident occurred at General Luna St., Purok Bantiyong, Brgy. Poblacion, Talisay City, Cebu. The fire was placed under control at around 5 PM and declared out at around 5:17 PM.
