

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rizal Lapuz Sur, Lapuz, Iloilo City

as of 21 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 March 2023 at around 8:57 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, Brgy. Rizal, Lapuz Sur, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 9:22 AM.
