2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 100,340 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 19,403 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 80,937 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 33,375 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱402.02 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.
