



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Strong Wind Incident in Alabel, Sarangani

as of 20 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 March 2023 at 2PM, a strong wind incident occurred in the Municipality of Alabel, Sarangani due to localized thunderstorms causing damages to houses.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **22 families** or **80 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Alabel**, **Sarangani** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱671.31 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 99,319 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 28,172 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 71,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 29,069 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱361.25 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
