

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 29 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2023, an armed conflict transpired between the 106th Brigade Division and alleged armed groups at the boundaries of Sitio Punol, Brgy. Udtong and Purok Zacaria, Brgy. Sigayan in the Municipality of Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **694 families** or **3,470 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There were **183 families** or **1,440 persons** who stayed at a **gym** in **Brgy. Udtong, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat** (see Table 2).
