

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sapangdaku, Cebu City as of 06 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2023 at around 2:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lupa, Brgy. Sapangdaku, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 PM.
