

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talayan, Quezon City as of 11 March 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 March 2023 at around 12:18 PM, a fire incident occurred at 199 Calamba St., Brgy. Talayan, Quezon City. The fire was declared out at around 2:01 PM.
