

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte

as of 10 March 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 February 2023, a fire incident occurred at Purok San Antonio, Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte. Based on the initial report of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) of the LGU of Iligan City in coordination with the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the fire was extinguished at around 3:55 PM upon arrival of their team. It was declared fire out at around 5:12 PM.
