



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Davao City

as of 15 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 February 2023 at around 1:06 PM, a fire incident occurred in Davao City. Based on initial investigation, the fire originally started at Purok 8, Brgy. 21-C Poblacion, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 5:21 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **978 families** or **2,920 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Davao City** (see Table 1).
