



# **DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Flooding Incident in Davao de Oro**

as of 19 March 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 13 March 2023 at 4PM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to the Low Pressure Area at 530 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.6°N, 130.8°E) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate with at times heavy rain in Caraga and Davao Region.

On 14 March 2023 at around 3AM, several municipalities in Davao de Oro experienced flooding due to heavy rains caused by the LPA.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **743 families** or **2,514 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Davao de Oro** (see Table 2).

#### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱671.83 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 104,819 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 38,672 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 66,147 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,459 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱353.1 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.





## b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

15 March 2023	DSWD FO XI provided FNIs such as FFP, modular tent, hygiene kit, and sleeping kit to the displaced families and individuals in Mawab, Davao de Oro.

### c. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection
