### I. Situation Overview

On 15 July 2022, at around 2:35 PM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Marulas, Valenzuela City. The fire was declared fire out at 4:57 PM.

A total of **₱1,754,250.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which **₱250,250.00** was provided by **DSWD**, **₱767,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱67,000.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱670,000.00** from **Other Partners** (see Table 4).
