

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Muzon, Taytay, Rizal

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 March 2023, at around 6:00 PM, a residential fire incident transpired in Brgy. Muzon, Taytay, Rizal.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **96 families** or **400 persons** are still taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Muzon, Taytay, Rizal** (see Table 2).
