





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in the Province of Masbate

30 March 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 March 2023 at around 10:20 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the Philippine Army and the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG) in Brgy. Villahermosa, Cawayan, Masbate. The incident happened in the vicinity of Villahermosa National High School which caused disturbance among the students and teachers. Another armed conflict also occurred in Brgy. Locso-an, Placer, Masbate on 22 March 2023 at around 7:15 AM. On the same day at around 10:40 AM, a sudden explosion occurred in the area resulting to the displacement of families and individuals in the neighboring municipalities.

A total of **1,160 families** or **5,248 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Province of Masbate** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P1,018,665.60** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex B).
