
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Displacement due to the Joint Police Operation in Brgy. Kimlawis, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur, 14 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

From 20 February to 17 March 2023, the Davao del Sur Police Provincial Office (DSPPO) and Kiblawan Municipal Police Station (MPS) conducted a joint operation in Brgy. Kimlawis, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur to implement the Simultaneous Anti-Criminality Law Enforcement Operation (SACLEO). As a result, families and individuals voluntarily left their houses to take shelter in safer grounds.

A total of **213 families** or **639 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Kimlawis, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur** (see Annex A).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided
