I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2023 at around 2PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Dilam, Calayan, Cagayan.

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Dilam, Calayan, Cagayan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,775.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱5,775.50** from **DSWD** and **₱3,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
