I. Situation Overview

On 29 March 2023 at around 2:07 PM, a fire incident occurred at P-2, Brgy. Poblacion, Barobo, Surigao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are three (3) families or 10 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Brgy. Poblacion Mosque in Barobo, Surigao del Sur (see Table 2).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱879,176.19** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which **₱585,971.19** from **DSWD**, **₱91,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱202,205.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)** (see Table 6).
