I. Situation Overview

On 29 March 2023 at around 2:07 PM, a fire incident occurred at P-2, Brgy. Poblacion, Barobo, Surigao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 4PM.

A total of **63 families** or **238 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Barobo, Surigao del Sur** (see Table 1).

There are **three (3) families** or **10 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Poblacion Mosque in Barobo, Surigao del Sur** (see Table 2).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided
