



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan

15 May 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 March 2023 at around 2PM, a fire incident occurred in three (3) adjacent barangays in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The fire was declared under control at around 2:30 PM.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **30 families** or **103 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Puerto Princesa City**, **Palawan** (see Table 2).
