

## DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon

as of 13 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bacbacon, Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and some allegedly unidentified armed groups.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **198 families** or **940 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon** (see Table 2).
