



DROMIC Report #4 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon

as of 15 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bacbacon, Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and some allegedly unidentified armed groups.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 481 families or 1,906 persons are affected in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 193 families or 817 persons currently taking temporary shelter in four (4) evacuation centers in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱33.48 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items
