



# DROMIC Report #5 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon

as of 18 April 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bacbacon, Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and some allegedly unidentified armed groups.

A total of **481 families** or **1,906 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cabadiangan**, **Kadingilan**, **Bukidnon** (see Table 1).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **193 families** or **817 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon** (see Table 2).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,540,643.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱811,630.00 from DSWD, ₱515,834.50 from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and ₱213,179.00 from other Partners (see Table 5).

- 54,705 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 23,177 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 31,443 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱263.03 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.
