

DROMIC Report #6 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon

as of 19 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2023, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Bacbacon, Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and some allegedly unidentified armed groups.

A total of **481 families** or **2,405 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **143 families** or **667 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Cabadiangan, Kadingilan, Bukidnon** (see Table 2).
