



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Gawa-an, Balbalan, Kalinga

as of 13 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 March 2023, a series of bombing incidents took place at Gubang, Brgy. Gawaan, Balbalan, Kalinga, which was reportedly attributed to terrorist groups. Related to this incident, two (2) armed encounters transpired between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the terrorist groups on 09 March 2023 and 13 March 2023.

A total of **236 families** or **1,130 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Gawa-an, Balbalan, Kalinga** (see Table 1).
