I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2023, at around 8AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Cangahan 1A and 1B in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the New People's Army (NPA).
