

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Isidro, Toboso, Negros Occidental

as of 08 April 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 April 2023 at around 3:45 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of the New People's Army at Sitio Seraje, Brgy. San Isidro, Toboso, Negros Occidental.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **65 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Toboso, Negros Occidental** (see Table 2).

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

- 87,117 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱275.9 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
