I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2023 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Wawa, Brgy. San Rafael, Rodriguez, Rizal between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the Communist Terrorist Group – New People's Army (CTG-NPA).

b. Other Activities

04 April 2023	 The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) of DSWD FO CALABARZON and the Quick Response Team (QRT) in the Province of Rizal were placed on heightened alert status to monitor the effects of the ongoing hot pursuit operations. The Municipal Action Team (MAT) in Rodriguez, Rizal and personnel from the Disaster Response Management Division
	(DRMD) were deployed to conduct data gathering and to validate information.
	DSWD FO CALABARZON advised the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Rodriguez, Rizal to review their Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM), Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection, and FNI Cluster Plans and ensure that COVID-19 safety protocols are incorporated.
	 DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the MSWDO for significant updates and any request of relief augmentation. DSWD FO CALABARZON coordinated with the Municipal Police Station (MPS) of the LGU of Rodriguez, Rizal and Police Regional Office (PRO) – CALABARZON for the provision of
	security personnel during the conduct of relief operations.
