



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao

as of 08 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 April 2023 at around 2:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the alleged members of two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups at the Market square of Brgy. Elian, Datu Saudi Ampatuan.

A total of **1,912 families** or **9,560 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Maguindanao** (see Table 1).

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,474 families** or **7,370 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **nine (9) evacuation centers** in **Maguindanao** (see Table 2).

- 70,140 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,293 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 34,847 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,342 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱288.6 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
