

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Escalante City, Negros Occidental

as of 21 April 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2023 at around 12PM, an armed conflict transpired in Escalante City, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the New People's Army (NPA).

A total of **181 families** or **585 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Escalante City, Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 43,105 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,977 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 31,128 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
