I. Situation Overview

On 03 April 2023 at around 10:45 PM, a mining site managed by the Tribal Mining Corporation at Sitio Tunnel, Brgy. Kematu, T'boli, South Cotabato has collapsed resulting in casualties.

- ₱283.1 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

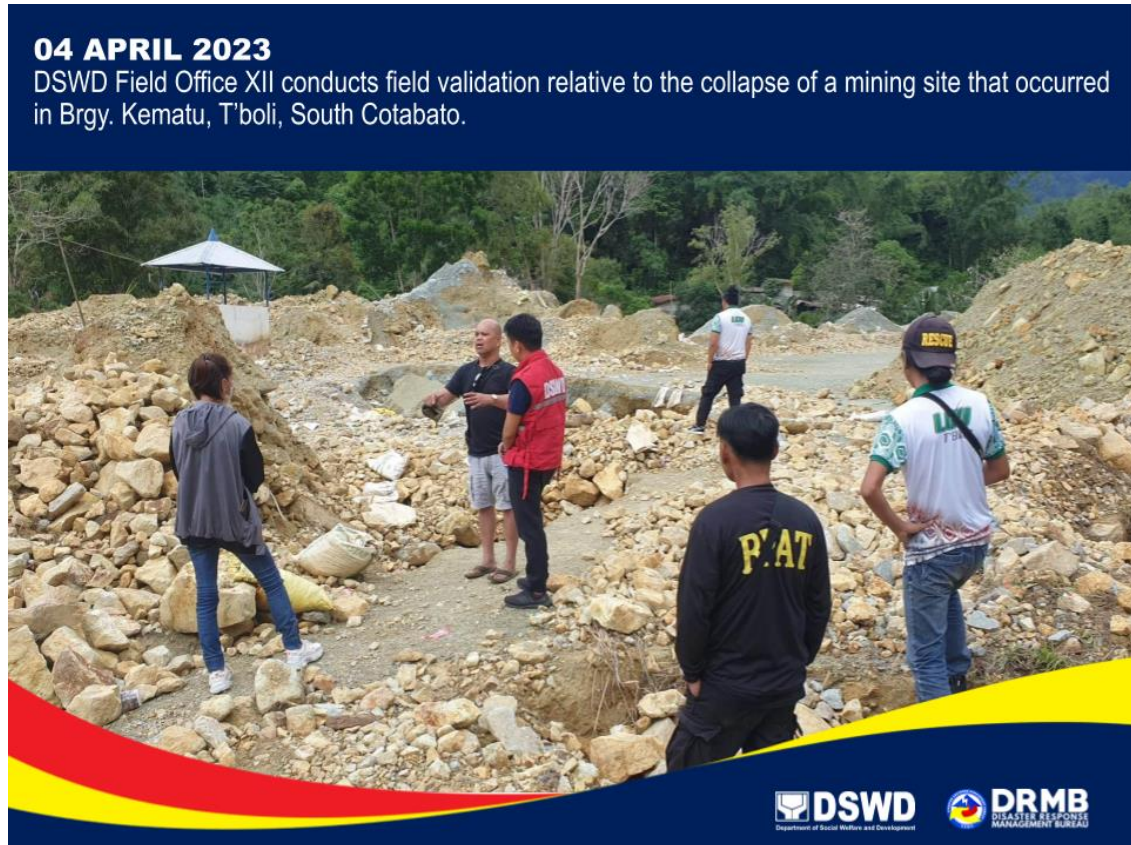
