### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱5.50 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 34,934 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 11,706 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 23,228 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,503 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱188.02 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.
