1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 81,540 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 34,893 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 46,647 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
