I. Situation Overview

On 18 April 2023 at around 11:35 AM, a fire incident occurred at Villa Verde, Brgy. Balulang, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 12:40 PM.


c. Other Activities
