## I. Situation Overview

On 09 April 2023 at around 1:59 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Orel, Brgy. Banilad, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 3:35 PM.

## 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 36,289 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,761 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 20,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 47,223 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱291.48 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
